OVERVIEW

Careers in the Hospitality, Tourism, and Recreation sector fall into three pathways: Food Science; Dietetics & Nutrition; Food Service & Hospitality; and Hospitality, Tourism, & Recreation.

In 2020, there were a total of 46,542 jobs in the Fresno, Tulare, and Kings County region, and more than half of those jobs were in Restaurants and Other Eating Places.
