## **OVERVIEW**

Careers in the Building and Construction Trades sector fall into four career pathways: Cabinetry, Millwork, & Woodworking; Engineering & Heavy Construction; Mechanical Systems Installation & Repair; and **Residential & Commercial Construction.** 

In 2020, there were a total of 28,196 jobs in the Fresno, Tulare, and Kings County region, and 19 percent of those jobs were in the Building Equipment Contractors industry.
