Visalia, CA — The 33rd Annual Tulare County Job Fair, the largest hiring event in the Central Valley, is set to return on Wednesday, October 1, 2025, from 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM at the Visalia Convention Center. Nearly 100 regional and local employers are expected, making this event a can't-miss opportunity for job seekers and businesses alike.

Last year, the job fair drew over 1,000 motivated job seekers from across the region, and this year's event promises to be even bigger. Employers from a wide range of industries will be onsite, offering full-time, part-time, entry-level, and skilled positions.

- Develop a plan for navigating the event and approaching employers

Additionally, Employment Connection will be on-site during the job fair to provide job seekers with real-time support. Staff will be available to:

- Review resumes
- Host mock interviews
- Help attendees prioritize which employers to visit

Veterans will receive early entry to the job fair beginning at 8:30 AM, providing them with exclusive early access to connect with employers before doors open to the general public.
