#### **OVERVIEW**

Careers in the Agriculture and Natural Resources sector fall into seven pathways: Agricultural Business; Agricultural Mechanics; Agriscience; Animal Science; Forestry & Natural Resources; Ornamental Horticulture; and Plant & Soil Science.

In 2023, there were a total of 96,274 jobs in the Fresno, Tulare, and Kings County region, and nearly half of those jobs were in support activities for crop production.

The graduate pipeline below shows the programs and schools in our region that produced the most graduates in 2021. The occupation table shown on the next page shows the availability and potential earnings for jobs in our region.
