

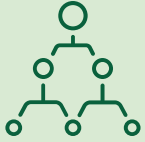

OVERVIEW

Careers in the Business and Finance sector fall into six pathways: Computer Applications; Taxes; Investments; Asset Management; International Business; and Business Management.

In 2020, there were a total of 65,580 jobs in the Fresno, Tulare, and Kings County region, and 6.6 percent of those jobs were in the Federal Government, Civilian industry.
