## OVERVIEW

Careers in the Health Science and Medical Technology sector fall into six pathways: Biotechnology; Patient Care; Health Care Administrative Services; Health Care Operational Support Services; Public & Community Health; and Mental & Behavioral Health.

In 2020, there were a total of 79,522 jobs in the Fresno, Tulare, and Kings County region, and more than 28 percent of those jobs were in the Individual and Family Services industry.
